National Committee/Structure:

- Access to an extensive international network of leading sustainability science professionals and institutions
- Capacity to connect and leverage national initiatives
- Representation in Future Earth Governance functions
- Limited access to Future Earth global resources

The Global Office:

- Increased national and international visibility, connectivity, and impact for the sustainability science community within the country / region
- Direct reciprocal access to Future Earth global resources (structures, platforms, programs, partner networks, knowledge and expertise) and programs
- An executive seat in the organization, integration with a global secretariat staff, as well as representation in the Future Earth Governance.
- Capacity to shape our collective input into national, regional and global sustainability science-policy platforms and processes (UNEA, HLPF, UNFCCC, CBD etc.), as well as the structure to engage in national level processes.
- Better access to national and international public and private funding, gained through integration into an international program.


